



# Native Plant of the Month

## Solomon's Seal

Solomon's Seal is an elegant plant with slender, arching stems that have alternating lance-shaped leaves that are either green or tipped with white. This deer resistant plant is somewhat slow to become established but is easy to grow.

Solomon's Seal looks best when allowed to naturalize in a woodland setting. It pairs well with many shade garden plants like Bleeding Heart, Ferns, Hosta and Coral Bells.

### **Planting tips:**

Start with rhizomes or transplants.

Plant 1-2 inches deep and 2-3 inches apart.

Plant in shady to part sun areas with moderate moisture.

No deadheading required – this plant is maintenance free.
