

July...in the garden!

- Cut mums to about half size for mid autumn blooming.
- Deadhead perennials to encourage re-blooming
- July is the last month to prune shrubs that bloom next spring on buds that are set this year. Examples include azalea, rhododendron, lilacs, forsythia and spirea.
- Apply a final feeding to rose bushes this month.
- Pull up spent, diseased or insect infested fruit and vegetable plants from your garden.
- Begin planning and seed selection for your fall/ winter garden. Peruse seed catalogues for best selection.
